
I have the pleasure of informing you that, by decision IDB.2/Dec.29 adopted on 23 October 1986, the Industrial Development Board, in response to your application, granted consultative status with UNIDO to your Organization in accordance with Article 19.1(b) of the Constitution and Guidelines established by the General Conference for the relationship agreement of UNIDO with intergovernmental, non-governmental and other organizations (GC.1/Dec.41, annex).

The Guidelines stipulate that the Board shall, at least every four years, review the list of organizations approved for consultative status. Concerning participation in the work of the General Conference and the Industrial Development Board, the Guidelines refer to the relevant provision of the Constitution of UNIDO, and in particular, of the rules of procedure of the Conference and of the Board (i.e. Rules 30.3(c) and 75.4(c) respectively).

Your contact person in UNIDO will continue to be Mr. Mile Janjic, Chief of the Section for Co-operation with Non-governmental Organizations and Industrial Enterprises.

I welcome the decision of the Board which reaffirms and formalizes the ties already existing between our two Organizations, and I look forward to closer co-operation in the future.
